

Eyes Wide Open in the Bus

Rosario, Argentina

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Rosario, Argentina has undertaken a citizen-focused security project to implement surveillance cameras on public buses. Hikvision mobile network devices were chosen to improve bus passenger safety.

CHALLENGE

- Instances of crimes and violence (especially on city buses or at bus stations) motivated the Argentine city of Rosario to improve safety and security measures on the Urban Transportation System.
- Increasing the police presence to include an officer on each bus was both cost-prohibitive as well as uncomfortable for some TUP passengers.

HIKVISION PRODUCTS ADOPTED

- 300 Mobile IPC DS-2CD6510D cameras
- 150 Mobile IPC DS-2CD6520D-10 cameras
- 150 NVR DSM 7508 HNI/GW/WI network video recorders

SOLUTION

- The project began with the provision of having fifty buses outfitted with three security cameras.
- All of the cameras are capable of recording audio as well as video.
- The cameras are connected to an NVR equipped to record 45 days of footage and save for review.
